Category Number	Category	Definitions
100	<b>Small</b> Pieced	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted. The perimeter of the quilt shall not be greater than 260". This category can include miniatures, wall hangings.
200	<b>Medium</b> Pieced	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted. The perimeter of the quilt shall be at least 261" but not greater than 330.
300	<b>Large</b> Pieced	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted. The perimeter of quilt shall be greater than 330".
400	<b>Small</b> Pieced by two	A quilt involving two (2) persons in its making and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. The perimeter of the quilt shall not be greater than 260". This category can include miniatures, wall hangings.
500	<b>Medium</b> Pieced by two	A quilt involving two (2) persons in its making and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. The perimeter of the quilt shall be at least 261" but not greater than 330".
600	<b>Large</b> Pieced by two	A quilt involving two (2) persons in its making and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. The perimeter of quilt shall be greater than 330".
700	<b>Small</b> Appliqué	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making and finishing. The applique work will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted. The perimeter of the quilt shall not be greater than 290". This category can include wall hangings, lap or baby quilts.
800	<b>Large</b> Appliqué.	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making and finishing. The applique work will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted. The perimeter of the quilt shall be larger than 290".
900	<b>Small</b> Appliqué by two	A quilt involving two (2) persons in its making and finishing. The applique work will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. The perimeter of the quilt shall not be greater than 290". This category can include wall hangings lap or wall quilts.

Category Number	Category	Definitions
1000	<b>Large</b> Appliqué by two	A quilt involving two (2) persons in its making and finishing. The applique work will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. The perimeter of quilt shall be greater than 290".
1100	Specialty Quilts.	Specialty techniques would include, but not be limited to, whole cloth, yo-yos, cathedral window, stenciled or embroidered. The quilts may be the work of one or two persons, including quilting for hire, and of any size.
1200	Group Quilt made by three (3) or more persons	Any size quilt that has been made by three or more persons. Quilts can be any techniques, pieced, appliqué or etc. Quilts may be hand or machine quilted including quilting for hire.
1300	Art/Innovative Design	Quilts will be an original design, reflecting innovative construction and/or design techniques, themes or subject matters. No commercial patterns or copies of previous works should be utilized. Major portion of surface must be fabric, may be of any technique or combination of techniques. The work must contain elements of quilting, i.e., surface, batting, backing with hand or machine stitching/quilting. All embellishments must be securely attached. Quilts can be of any size. Quilts may be the work of one or more persons.
1400	Wearable Art and Accessories and Home Decorations.	This category will include wearable items, functional or decorative items such as table-toppers, table runners, bags, boxes, etc. Items must contain a surface design and backing. The surface design can be constructed using any/or multiple techniques: piecing, patchwork, appliqué, yo-yo, and embroidery, and may include either hand or machine quilting.
1500	Youth – all ages 17 years and under.	Quilts can be any size and must be composed of three layers: a top, batting (filler) and backing. They are to be hand and/or machine quilted or tied. The surface design can be constructed using any/or multiple techniques, piecing, appliqué, yo-yo, embroidery, etc.. The youth may have assistance in any stage of the process. Youth will designate the percentage of assistance on the entry form.
1600	Miniature	A miniature quilt is a design that has been reduced in scale. All components---overall design, quilting design and stitches, binding, embroidery or other surface techniques or embellishments need to be reduced in scale. When photographed with no scale for comparison the miniature shall look like a full size quilt, and only when a comparison is applied should the smallness be seen. The perimeter of the miniature quilt shall not be greater than 96", and no side should exceed more than 24".
2000	All Non – Judged Entries	All sizes and techniques
