Lori Wagner started sewing at an early age. Barbie clothes and outfits for a very patient dog were her first creative endeavors, all sewn by hand as her mother refused to teach her to sew or to let her use the sewing machine. Trial and error have been the hallmarks of this long-lived fascination with sewing. At age 13 Lori and her mother made their first quilt together, and have been collaborating on quilting designs and quilts ever since. Lori has a degree in Clothing and Textiles and therefore is interested in the mechanics of sewing as well as the artistic merits of making items of beauty.

Carol Anne Wagner taught junior high home ec (hence the refusal to teach her own daughter to sew) and saw all the mistakes humanly possible right there in the classroom. Quilting has become her main interest and she has made quilts covering all genres of style and technique. She has great skill in designing easy-to-use patterns for novice and advanced quilters and is still teaching, despite her early home ec experiences.

Together, Lori and Carol Anne have owned and operated Granny's Attic in McCall since 1989. Classes, retreats, their original pattern and kit productions, and making more quilts consume them to the point of great delight and mild insanity. What a wonderful way to share their talents!
