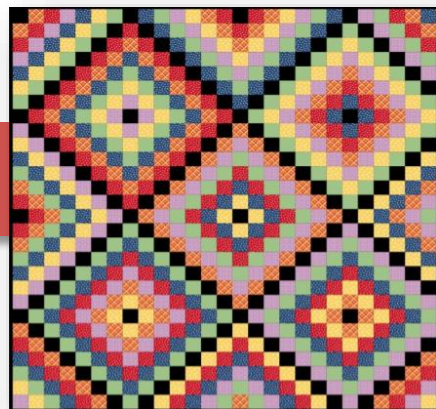

FRI. March 22: "Vintage Charm"

Piece this classic quilt with NO strip piecing. Carmen's AccuQuilt tools and techniques help learners of all skill levels create fast, perfect corners in this fun 54 x 56" (before borders) quilt. **Class to be held at Jones Sew & Vac: 7615 W Fairview Ave, Boise**



Course Cost: \$55 for BBQ Members, \$65 Non-Members

+ \$25 Kit: Kit includes 6 panels of Tensisters EasyPiecing Grid, Quilt Pattern, Step-By-Step Handouts

Supplies to Bring: Sewing Machine with 1/4" piecing foot, cutting mat, rotary cutter.

+ Fabric: 1/2 yard each of 6 fabrics (or scraps, fat quarters, etc. equal to yardage), or 40-60 pre-cut 2.5" squares of each color plus 80 chain squares (black in this picture).



SAT. March 23: "Block Party"

Make a traditional sampler quilt using non-traditional piecing with the innovative EasyPiecing Grid. Completing this 60 x 60" heirloom quilt looks complex, but Carmen Geddes technique and tools enable quilters of all skill levels to complete the project with perfect corners and stable, flat blocks quickly and easily! **Class to be held at Boise Rigging Supply, 6750 W. Victory Road, Boise**

Course Cost: \$55 for BBQ Members, \$65 Non-Members

+ \$25 Kit: Kit includes 6 panels of Tensisters EasyPiecing Grid, Quilt Pattern, Step-By-Step Handouts

Supplies to Bring: Sewing Machine with 1/4" piecing foot, ruler for squaring half-square triangles, basic sewing supplies.

+ Fabric: 1/4 yard each of 8-10 fabrics (or scraps, fat quarters, etc. equal to yardage), 1-1/2 yards of background, border one and sashing 1-1/2 yards.
