You are solely responsible for entering in the correct category.

Any size limitations are based on the perimeter measurement (total distance around the edge of the quilt). For a rectangular quilt, the perimeter measurement = 2 x (width plus length)

Category Number	Category	Definitions
100	Small Pieced by One <u>Quilted by Maker</u> (one person only)	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making, quilting & finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted. This category can include a wall hanging, lap quilt or baby quilt. The perimeter shall not be greater than 200 inches.
200	Small Pieced by Two or More	A quilt involving two or more persons in its making, quilting and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. This category can include a wall hanging, lap quilt, or baby quilt. The perimeter shall not be greater than 200 inches.
300	Medium Pieced by One <u>Quilted by Maker</u> (one person only)	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making, quilting and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted. The perimeter shall be at least 201 inches but not greater than 300 inches.
400	Medium Pieced by Two or More	A quilt involving two or more persons in its making, quilting and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. The perimeter shall be at least 201 inches but not greater than 300 inches.
500	Large Pieced by One <u>Quilted by Maker</u> (one person only)	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making, quilting and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted. The perimeter shall be greater than 300 inches.
600	Large Pieced by Two or More	A quilt involving two or more persons in its making, quilting and finishing. The piecing or patchwork will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. The perimeter shall be greater than 300 inches.
700	Applique by one <u>Quilted by Maker</u> (one person only)	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making, quilting and finishing. The appliqué work will be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted. The quilt may be of any size.
800	Applique by Two or More	A quilt involving two or more persons in its making, quilting and finishing. The appliqué work must be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted, including quilting for hire. The quilt may be of any size.
900	Mixed Technique by one <u>Quilted by Maker</u> (one person only)	A quilt involving one (1) person in its making, quilting and finishing. A quilt where two or more construction and/or surface design techniques are used to develop the design of the top. (This is in addition to the quilting or trapunto.) Construction and/or surface design techniques must be used in significant amounts that affect the overall design. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted. The quilt may be of any size.
1000	Mixed Technique by Two or more persons	A quilt involving two or more persons in its making, quilting and finishing. A quilt where two or more construction and/or surface design techniques are used to develop the design of the top. (This is in addition to the quilting or trapunto.) Construction and/or surface design techniques must be used in significant amounts that affect the overall design. The quilt may be hand or machine quilted. The quilt may be of any size.

Category Number	Category	Definitions
1100	Miniature	A miniature quilt is a design that has been reduced in scale. All components---overall design, quilting design and stitches, binding, embroidery or other surface techniques or embellishments need to be reduced in scale. When photographed with no scale for comparison the miniature shall look like a full size quilt, and only when a comparison is applied should the smallness be seen. <u>No side shall exceed 24"</u> . The perimeter shall not be greater than 96 inches.
1200	Modern	A quilt that uses a new design or reinterpreted traditional design, including improvisational piecing, alternative block structures, emphasis of negative space and or asymmetry. The quilt can be of any size and be the work of one or more persons.
1300	Art	The quilt <i>must be an original design</i> , reflecting innovative construction and/or design techniques, themes or subject matters. No commercial patterns or copies of previous works can be utilized. Major portion of surface must be fabric. It may be of any technique or combination of techniques. The work must contain elements of quilting, i.e., surface, batting, backing, with hand or machine stitching/quilting. All embellishments must be securely attached. The quilt can be of any size and may be the work of one or more persons.
1400	Specialty	Any quilt that does not fit into any other category. It would include, but not be limited to, whole cloth, yo-yos, cathedral window, crazy quilts, for example. The quilt may be the work of one or more persons, and of any size.
1500	First Time Exhibitor	Any quilter who has NEVER entered a quilt in ANY show or competition before. It may be of any technique or combination of techniques. The work must contain elements of quilting, i.e., surface, batting, backing, with hand or machine stitching/quilting. All embellishments must be securely attached. The quilt can be of any size and may be the work of one or more persons.
1600	Small Group Challenge (Exhibit Only)	These Small Group Quilts should be individual quilts, each with a perimeter no larger than 120 inches and must have a stated challenge. Each group must enter at least four (4) quilts. Each entry must provide a photo.
1700	Youth	The quilt can be any size and must be composed of three layers: a top, batting (filler) and backing. It may be hand and/or machine quilted or tied. The surface design can be constructed using any/or multiple techniques, piecing, appliqué, yo-yo, embroidery, etc. The youth must be involved in the construction, but may have assistance in any stage of the process. Youth will designate the percentage of work performed on the entry form.
2000	Exhibit Only	Any quilted technique may be entered. No framed work. Quilts larger than 88" x 105" <u>will be folded</u> for hanging.
