PLEASE READ THESE OFFICIAL RULES CAREFULLY

Quilts will be folded during processing.

GENERAL

- 1) A quilt shall be composed of three layers: a top, batting (filler) and a backing and be hand and/or machine stitched (for backing and quilting exceptions see Entries and Fees, Rule #3, and category descriptions.) Each maker (entrant) may enter only 1 (one) quilt per judged category.
- 2) Quilts displayed in previous BBQ shows cannot be entered. The finished quilt must have been completed within two years at the time of the show (after September 30, 2018).
- 3) Quilts must be in clean and excellent condition. **They must be free of all stains, pet hairs, lint, and odors.** When evidence of **pet hair, lint, or odors** is identified, the quilt **will be isolated without being judged or shown**. No entry fee will be refunded.
- 4) To insure fairness in judging, you must check the appropriate boxes on the Entry Form. Please check if it is a Kit or the equivalent of a Kit for all judged categories. (Kit equivalent refers to a package or series of packages which includes a pattern and the majority of the top fabrics preselected by the package vendor.) Kitted quilts are not eligible for Best of Show but are eligible for other awards.
- 5) The decision for the category entered is the sole responsibility of the maker (entrant). Quilt may **not** be moved by an entrant to another category after the entry form is processed. Any quilt in the wrong category will not be judged and no entry fee will be refunded. However, the Quilt Show Committee and/or the judges reserve the right to divide or combine categories, move entries to a more appropriate category or not display a quilt deemed inappropriate for the show. Judges decisions regarding awards are final.
- 6) Standard hanging in pipe-and-drape can accommodate quilts up to 88” long and 105” wide. Longer/wider quilts **will be folded** to hang.
- 7) **AGAIN THIS YEAR! – Quilts for Sale** -If you wish to sell your quilt, indicate yes on the form and state the price. BBQ will collect 15% of the sales price. Allow 2 weeks to receive your proceeds

Entries and Fees

- 1) There are three (3) different ways to enter a quilt.
 - a) “Judged” Entry: Categories 100-1500
 - b) “Youth” Entry: Category 1700 (**entrant making the quilt must be no older than 17 years of age at the time of the Quilt Show**);
 - c) “Exhibit Only” Entry: Category 1600 – Small Group Challenge and Category 2000 - Exhibit Only.
- 2) Entry Fees (non-refundable)
 - a) **Youth Entry**- Category 1700-there is no fee for a youth quilt. Only one entry per maker may be entered.
 - b) **BBQ Members**
Judged: Each maker (entrant) may enter **only one entry per category**. The fee is \$5.00 per quilt.
Exhibit Only - Category 1600 and 2000: There is no limit on the number of quilts you enter in these categories.
 - c) **Non-Members**- ALL adult entries: The entry fee is \$10.00 per entry in **all** categories, including Category 1600 - “Small Group Challenge” – and Category 2000 -“Exhibit Only.”

- 3) Quilts with 'false backs' will be accepted for "Exhibit Only." In the Judged categories the quality and workmanship on a quilt must be evaluated from both the front and back without barriers, i.e. backing paper, cloth, etc. Framed work will not be accepted. **Backing/Batting Exceptions: Category 1400, Specialty Quilts;** where quilting is not traditional i.e. Crazy Quilts, Yo-Yo Quilts, etc.
- 4) Every effort will be made to judge all quilts entered for judging. However, due to time constraints, all entry forms must be received before or on August 20, 2020.
- 5) **Every entry whether printed or downloaded must include:**
 - a. A fully completed and signed entry form indicating:
 - i) **Category Number:** For category descriptions, see Boise Basin Quilters' Quilt Show 2020 Entry Categories at www.boisebasinquilters.org/quiltshow/entries. **Please read** the descriptions carefully and if there are any questions as to the appropriate category, contact Joann Hopkins (see below).
 - ii) **Physical size:** Refer to the definitions for each category to determine appropriate category. The Perimeter is the outside measurement of the quilt. For a rectangular quilt, (Width plus length) X 2. Please be accurate with your measurements.
 - iii) **Type of Quilting:**
 - **Track:** The machine is mounted on a track and you move the machine over the stationary quilt.
 - **Computer-Generated:** The quilting is designed on a computer and the computer guides the quilting.
 - **Stationary:** The machine is stationary and you move the quilt under the machine.
 - **Hand:** No machine is used in the quilting process (the piecing may be by machine).
 - b. **Entry fee must accompany entry form.**
 - c. **A Color Photo 4" x 6"** of the quilt top **must be attached** to every paper form. The online form requires a photo download. Please indicate "TOP" of quilt on photo. For identification and security purposes, no entry form will be accepted without the photo.
 - d. The completed entry form(s) and photos **must** be submitted on or before the **August 20, 2020** membership meeting. Completed form(s) can be mailed to Madeleine Trainor (see below). Quilts will be received separately, see 'Quilt Take-in' below.

6) Quilt Take-in: NO LATE QUILTS WILL BE ACCEPTED – NO EXCEPTIONS

NO quilts will be accepted at the September general meeting. Quilt take-in is September 21, 2020.

Quilts **will be** accepted:

- On Monday, September 21, 2020 at "Western Town," Expo Idaho, 5610 N Glenwood St. Boise, ID 83714 between the hours of **10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.**
- Western Town is located at Expo Idaho behind the quilt show venue. There is free parking at Western Town. If you are unable to bring your quilt to Expo Idaho at this time, please make arrangements for someone to bring it for you; **or**
- BY APPOINTMENT through September 18, 2020. Contact Madeleine Trainor (see below).
- **Shipped quilts** must be received by **September 18, 2020** to Madeleine Trainor (see below) with required paper label attached as per directions on label sheet. In addition, return shipping label and insurance fees **MUST** also be provided if the quilt will not be picked up in person on Saturday, September 28 (see Quilt pick-up, #7 below).

- 7) **Quilt pick-up** will be on Saturday, September 26, between **6pm & 7pm**. **The person picking up the quilt must present the claim check identifying the quilt. If you do not have your claim check receipt, you must wait until all other entries have been picked up before your request will be processed and your entry returned to you.**
