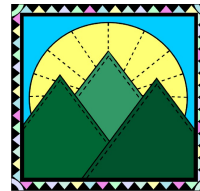

Boise Basin Quilters Guild - 2023 Quilt Show  
September 29-30, 2023 Boise, Idaho - Expo Idaho

### PLEASE READ THESE OFFICIAL RULES CAREFULLY

Quilts will be folded during processing.

No quilts larger than 100" x 100"



## GENERAL

- 1) A quilt shall be composed of three layers: a top, batting (filler) and a backing and be hand and/or machine stitched (for backing and quilting exceptions see Entries and Fees, Rule #3, and category descriptions.) Each maker (entrant) may enter only 1 (one) quilt per judged category.
- 2) Quilts displayed in previous BBQ shows cannot be entered. The finished quilt must have been completed within two years at the time of the show (after September 30, 2021.)
- 3) Quilts must be in clean and excellent condition. **They must be free of all stains, pet hairs, lint, and odors.** When evidence of **pet hair, lint, or odors** is identified, the quilt **will be isolated without being judged or shown**. No entry fee will be refunded.
- 4) To insure fairness in judging, you must check the appropriate boxes on the Entry Form. Note that all kitted quilts (or equivalents) are to be entered into the new WORKMANSHIP category and could be disqualified if entered into any other category. WORKMANSHIP quilts ARE NOT eligible for Best of Show.
- 5) The decision for the category entered is the sole responsibility of the maker (entrant). Quilt may **not** be moved by an entrant to another category after the entry form is processed. Any quilt in the wrong category will not be judged and no entry fee will be refunded. However, the Quilt Show Committee and/or the judges reserve the right to divide or combine categories, move entries to a more appropriate category or not display a quilt deemed inappropriate for the show. Judges decisions regarding awards are final.
- 6) Unless otherwise stated in a category, quilt perimeters should not exceed 440 inches, that is no more than 110 inches per side. (The Perimeter is the outside measurement of the quilt. For a rectangular quilt, (width plus length) X 2. Please be accurate with your measurements.) Our pipe-and-drape exhibit can accommodate quilts up to 88" long and 105" wide. Longer/wider quilts **will be folded** to hang. Quilts longer than 88" must have a 4" sleeve on bottom back.
- 7) **AGAIN THIS YEAR! – Quilts for Sale** -If you wish to sell your quilt, indicate yes on the form and state the price. BBQ will collect 15% of the sales price. Allow 2 weeks to receive your proceeds.

## Entries and Fees

- 1) There are three (3) different ways to enter a quilt.
  - a) "Judged" Entry: Categories 200-2000
  - b) "Youth" Entry: Category 2100 (**entrant making the quilt must be no older than 17 years of age at the time of the Quilt Show**)
  - c) "Exhibit Only" Entry: Category 2200-2400. This includes Exhibit Only, Small Group Challenge and Red/White Theme
- 2) Entry Fees (non-refundable)
  - a) **Youth Entry**- Category 2100 -there is no fee for a youth quilt. Only one quilt per maker may be entered.
  - b) **BBQ Members**

**Judged:** Each maker (entrant) may enter **only one quilt per category**. The fee is \$5.00 per quilt.

**Exhibit Only** - Category 2200. There is no limit on the number of quilts you enter in this category. No fee required for guild members.
  - c) **Non-Members**- ALL adult entries: The entry fee is \$40 per first entry and \$10 per quilt after that first entry in all categories, including "Small Group Challenge" Category 2300 and "Exhibit Only" Category 2200. (Small Group challenge entries are entered by one person who pays one fee.)

- 3) Quilts with 'false backs' will be accepted for "Exhibit Only." In the Judged categories the quality and workmanship on a quilt must be evaluated from both the front and back without barriers, i.e. backing paper, cloth, etc. Framed work will not be accepted. **Category 1900: Backing/Batting Exceptions: Category Other Techniques By One or More** where quilting is not traditional i.e. Crazy Quilts, Yo-Yo Quilts, etc.

## ENTRY FORMS

- 4) Every effort will be made to judge all quilts entered for judging. Due to time constraints, all ENTRY FORMS (no quilts) must be received before or on August 17, 2023. Quilt submission not required until September 25, 2023. See below.
- 5) **Every entry whether printed or downloaded must include:**
- a. A fully completed and signed entry form indicating:
    - i) **Category Number:** For category descriptions, [CLICK HERE](#). **Please read** the descriptions carefully and if there are any questions as to the appropriate category, contact Vicki Francis. (See below).
    - ii) **Physical size:** Refer to the definitions for each category to determine appropriate category. The Perimeter is the outside measurement of the quilt. For a rectangular quilt, (width plus length) X 2. Please be accurate with your measurements.
    - iii) Quilt Label should be attached to bottom, right side on back of quilt. Find quilt label [HERE](#).
    - iv) Type of Quilting: see information on quilt label.
  - b. **Entry fee must accompany entry form.**
  - c. Photo of each quilt must be included.
    - i) **PRINTED SUBMISSIONS: A Color Photo 4" x 6"** of the quilt top **must be attached** to every paper form. Please indicate "TOP" of quilt on printed photo.
    - ii) **ONLINE SUBMISSIONS:** The online form requires a photo upload. For identification and security purposes, no entry form will be accepted without a photo.
  - d. The completed entry form(s) and photos **must** be submitted on or before the August 17, 2023 membership meeting. Completed form(s) can be mailed to Joann Hopkins (see below). Quilts will be received separately, see 'Quilt Take-in' below.

## 6) QUILT TAKE-IN: NO LATE QUILTS WILL BE ACCEPTED – NO EXCEPTIONS

NO quilts will be accepted at the September general meeting. Quilt take-in is September 25, 2023. Quilts **will be** accepted:

- On Monday, September 25, 2023 at "Western Town," Expo Idaho, 5610 N Glenwood St. Boise, ID 83714 between the hours of **12:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

Western Town is located at Expo Idaho behind the quilt show venue.

Free parking is available at Western Town.

If you are unable to bring your quilt to Expo Idaho at this time, please make arrangements for someone to bring it for you.

- **Shipped quilts** must be received by September 22, 2023 by Joann Hopkins (see below) with required paper label attached as per directions on label sheet. In addition, return shipping label and insurance fees **MUST** also be provided if the quilt will not be picked up in person on September 30 (see Quilt pick-up, #7 below).

- 7) **Quilt pick-up** will be on Saturday, September 30, between **6pm & 7pm**. **The person picking up the quilt must present the claim check identifying the quilt. If you do not have your claim check receipt, you must wait until all other entries have been picked up before your request will be processed and your entry returned to you.**
