Kid For A Night is St. Luke's Children's signature event, emphasizing the "fun" in fundraising. This annual celebration encourages more than 800 adults (21 and over) to act like kids again. The event includes a themed evening of games and activities, music, dancing, spectacular live & silent auctions and a delicious dinner. It's not your typical gala—we ask our attendees to come dressed up for the theme or in their favorite jeans and t-shirt. Not only is Kid For A Night a wonderful opportunity to have a great time, the event makes a difference to the kids at St. Luke's Children's. Kid For A Night has raised more than \$11.5 million since its inception in 1992. This year, we ask our guests to time travel to their favorite decade and join us for a night at the Kid For A Night Time Warp!

Miracle Bear Project

Each year, we sell Miracle Bears, which are adorned in handmade costumes fit to our theme, for our event sponsors, community members and supporters to purchase. Each bear is \$100 and the donor has the opportunity to keep the bear or donate it back to the children's hospital for one of our patients to enjoy. As you would likely assume, the bears are almost always donated back to the hospital and it's such a heartwarming experience getting to deliver them to the kiddos we care for. 100% of the funds raised from the event, including the miracle bear purchases, benefit the children's hospital directly!

To add a special touch, the bears all have hand crafted outfits that match our theme. Some are hand crocheted and some have handmade fabric costumes. Not all have to be super intricate so they can vary in terms of design.

Quantity:

- **50 Bears Total** - *roughly 10 in tall and 5 in wide.
 - If you feel you can contribute more than 50, we can certainly chat and provide you with more bears to handcraft outfits for.

Outfit Ideas:

The outfits vary from hand crocheted, sewn with fabrics, tulle, etc. They also have sewn on accessories (that are not a choking hazard and stay on the bear), such as sunglasses, hats, head pieces, etc.
