Gift Garden Agreement and Guidelines for Donated Items**

- Donated items must be handcrafted, completed, and of the same quality as other items being offered for sale.
- This is *not* an opportunity to off-load old, partially completed, or no longer needed or wanted items. The Gift Garden prides itself on presenting beautiful handmade items to the public. No exceptions for donated items!
- Items not meeting the criteria specified will not be accepted for sale.
- Items must be priced appropriately – commensurate with the pricing of items not being donated. If you are unsure of how to price your items Gift Garden staff will price them after receiving them.
- If you are pricing these items please be sure that the tag you attach is secure.
- Proceeds for the sale of these items will go to the BBQ guild.
- BBQ accepts no responsibility for any items lost, stolen, or damaged. Items are not covered by any insurance. Every year there are stolen, lost, or unaccounted for items and while this has not been a significant problem, the possibility that one of the items that disappears or is damaged could be yours.
- Submission of items indicates acceptance of these guidelines.

Important!!!

Drop-off: Thursday, September 24, 2026

- All donated items for sale must be dropped off **between 10:00 AM and 6:00 PM** at the Expo Building. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Unsold items: Saturday, September 26, 2026

- If you would like to have your unsold items returned to you please complete a vendor inventory sheet including descriptions of each item. As you will not have a vendor number an item code is not required and should not be included on your tags if you are pricing your items.
- Arrangements for the return of unsold items will be made **after the show**. Be sure to include your email address on your vendor inventory sheet to expedite making these arrangements.
- **DO NOT** come to the Gift Garden at the conclusion of the show expecting to receive your unsold items. Our check out system for Gift Garden vendors is time consuming and critical to ensure that those vendors receive accurate payment for goods sold and we do not want to complicate that process nor make you waste time waiting.
- If you do not wish to have your unsold items returned to you we will handle donating them appropriately – to the BBQ kid’s quilt project, other special projects, the Idaho Youth Ranch, or the ReUse Market.
