

Quilt Sleeve instructions

To make the sleeve: Use a strip of fabric the full width of the quilt and 14" wide; fold the strip in half the full length; sew it together with a ½" seam (the result is a long tube/sleeve); turn it inside out which places the seam inside the tube/sleeve; iron the tube/sleeve with the seam in the middle; place the pressed tube/sleeve with the seam against the back of the quilt; pin the tube/sleeve to the quilt back one inch from the bottom. Please handstitch both the TOP and BOTTOM of the sleeve to the back of the quilt. Stitching of the sleeve will not be judged. Take care to not go through to the front of the quilt. (See following illustration.)



Place sleeve about 1-inch from bottom back.

Baste both top and bottom of the sleeve to quilt back.
